Purpose:

Award outstanding 4-H Sedgwick County Fair participants scholarship support for future educational endeavors.

Awards:

2 Scholarships at \$250 each. Winners are chosen by the Livestock Sales Committee along with the Foundation Selection Committee.

Scholarships awarded to current 4-H beef, sheep, swine, and meat goat members.

Eligibility:

- ◆ Current high school senior with plans to enroll in a post secondary educational program.
- ◆ Have not previously received this scholarship.
- ◆ Current 4-H member exhibiting at the County Fair who is a high school senior or first year college student.

Application Process:

- ◆ Completed Kansas 4-H Scholarship Application available at the Sedgwick County Extension Education Center.
- ◆ A letter from the applicant to the Selection Committee outlining future educational plans.
- ◆ Due date March 1st, 5:00 p.m., to: Sedgwick County Extension Service, 7001 West 21st Street North, Wichita, KS 67205-1759.
- ◆ One additional letter of recommendation from a livestock industry representative.
- ◆ Complete the section below and on the back.

Selection Criteria:

- ◆ 4-H activities and leadership (40 points)
- ◆ Participation in Sedgwick County Fair (40 points)
- ◆ Other activities and work experience (40 points)
- ◆ References (40 points)
- ◆ Career Plans (40 points)
