It's time for 4-H Day! We've got a great line up with lots of variety to see and hear. We're in a new location so please take time to read all the information.

Skits, dance and model meetings will be on the stage, B16. The "curtain side" will actually be a portable wall, so it will turn the stage into a room. It will be long and narrow, similar to the size we have had before. The performance area will be approximately 10' deep and 20' wide. There will be no raised area. As usual, there will not be any back or side curtains. Clubs are encouraged to improvise and use their imagination to create off stage areas for actors to wait.

Skits and large groups can gather in room B1. There is room for your props and other things. For the model meeting, everyone should bring a folding chair from room B1 and then return it to the room when finished.

Due to numbers, instrumental and vocal will be in one room with one judge – B2. Piano is in B6.

Musicians Remember – there are no practice or warm up rooms for music. You can use B1. If not memorized, you will need a copy of music for you and for the judge. Remember to number your measures!!! All music rooms have a piano. You may also use a CD/tape for accompaniment. It's your responsibility to provide the CD player and extension cord. Accompanists do not have to be 4-H members.

Gathering rooms for clubs will be E10, E11, E12. No one room is assigned to any club. Everyone will share the space. Please be respectful and share space equitably. No kitchen facilities are available

Performance rooms will be E1, E2, E3, E4. The rooms are smaller and hallway will be congested. Please be courteous. For demonstrations and project talks, we will have a PC compatible LCD projector set up in each room. You will need to provide your own lap top. If you are using an Apple product, you will need to bring an adaptor to hook up to the LCD projector. We will provide easels for posters as we have done in the past.

Concession stand will be available mid-morning when the basketball tournament starts. It will be located near the gym, just off the cafetorium. All food **must remain** in that area. **Do Not bring food and drinks into the rooms!!!** 

Remember we are guests and we need to leave things in the same condition as we found them!!

#### **Parent Helpers Needed**

As you can see, we have a full morning of activities and events. We especially need some **extra parent helpers for the judging contests**. Younger members need some help filling out the form, helping them with reading and explaining the process to them. A shift is 1 hour in time.

Our contest coordinators will explain what needs to be done the day of the event, but we'd like to have an idea of who can help. All contests will be set up to run from 9 am to noon.

#### 4-H Day Chairman and Room Monitor Duties

Chairmen – you are responsible for making sure a room monitor is at the door during your event. You don't replace them, you make sure they know what to do, and you fill in when there is no one available. Make sure they have the notebook with score sheets, pencils, schedule, etc. When your room is finished, return easels or any other equipment to the 4-H office area; put chair/tables back in room; take signs off the door and return to the 4-H office area.

Room Monitors – you are the 'welcome wagon' for the participants. BE BOLD!! SPEAK UP! BE ALERT! When someone comes to the room, ask if they are a presenter. If so, check their name on the list and let them know if you are running on time or not. Give them a score sheet and ask them to fill out the top part of the form. Then you hold on to the score sheet and give it to the judge when they are ready. This will help you keep on track and know who is next. If someone asks for a time change, be sure to check with the other participants to see if they can switch. If that's not possible, then they will need to stick with their original time. Make sure that they door is closed during the presentations. Open the door after the applause, so that new people can come in.

If there is a blank below, it means that we have an opening. You must be at least 12 to volunteer or if younger, you need an adult/older member to help you. Call the 4-H office to volunteer 660-0115.

Note: If you signed up to volunteer and your name is not listed below, it's because you had a very complicated schedule ③ . Just check in with the 4-H desk on the day of the event, and we will see where we need some help.


