The Helping Hand Award is given to the 4-H'er who excels at helping younger 4-H members at 4-H Days, County Fair, or other county-wide events. The nominee should also demonstrate good sportsmanship, support for superintendents or volunteers, strong ethics, and concern for others. The award is presented at the 4-H Recognition Banquet in November. Nominees should be **12 years of age** by January 1. Nominations are accepted throughout the year with a cut off date of **September 15**.

Nominations may be made by any 4-H member, project leader, or other volunteers. Parents should not nominate their own children.
