# RECORD BOOK COMPETITION AWARD FORM Due to 4-H Department by October 1 

Each year at the Banquet, a county-wide award is presented for the club with the highest percentage of record book completion. The top 4 clubs will be recognized and receive a 4-H mall gift certificate.

To calculate, use the number of confirmed 4-H members this year as of March 1 deadline. The official deadline is listed below.

From this total, subtract the number of 4-H members who have not re-enrolled for the current $4-\mathrm{H}$ year. This is so that the club is not penalized for the 4 -H'ers who graduate or choose not to join again.

Count the number of record books that are turned into you at the club level (these do not need to be turned into the office). Record books should include personal pages, story, permanent record and project information.

To compute:
Official number of members minus those not re-enrolling = $\qquad$

Number of record books turned in to you divided by the = $\qquad$ \% number of members on the line above.
