Backyard Birds

Grade: K-3 (ages 5-8)

Group: max 30 youth

Time: 60 minutes

Students will learn about all the different birds that one might see in their own backyard in Kansas. This lesson starts off with a discussion on what birds youth might already know about, followed by a book about backyard birds and their music. Finally, students will have the chance to illustrate their very own ornithologist's journal where they can document all of their future bird-watching adventures!
