Painted Lady butterfly hatching project

Butterfly Larvae Pick-Up Date: April 4, 2019 4 pm-6 pm in the Sunflower Room

Grade: K-4

Watch Painted Lady caterpillars grow, form chrysalides and hatch into butterflies. Learn about the anatomy, life cycle and the role of a butterfly in its environment. Compare the similarities and differences between a butterfly and a moth. The butterfly life cycle takes three to four weeks to complete.

Teacher Provides:

- ▶ Pick up butterfly larvae at Sedgwick County Extension Office, 7001 W. 21st St on April 4, 2019.
- ▶ Continuous care and supervision of larvae, chrysalides and butterflies until released outside.
- ▶ Butterfly cage (plans available or you may purchase one on the order form) and other supplies (butterfly food, etc.)

Program Includes:

- ▶ Lesson plans and resource information
- ▶ Butterfly larva cups (3 to 5 larvae) with larvae food are available for purchase at \$23.00
- ▶ OPTIONAL. Small mesh pop-up butterfly enclosure to keep insects contained for classroom observation. Available to purchase for an additional \$10.00.
- ▶ Partial scholarships available to Title I schools.
