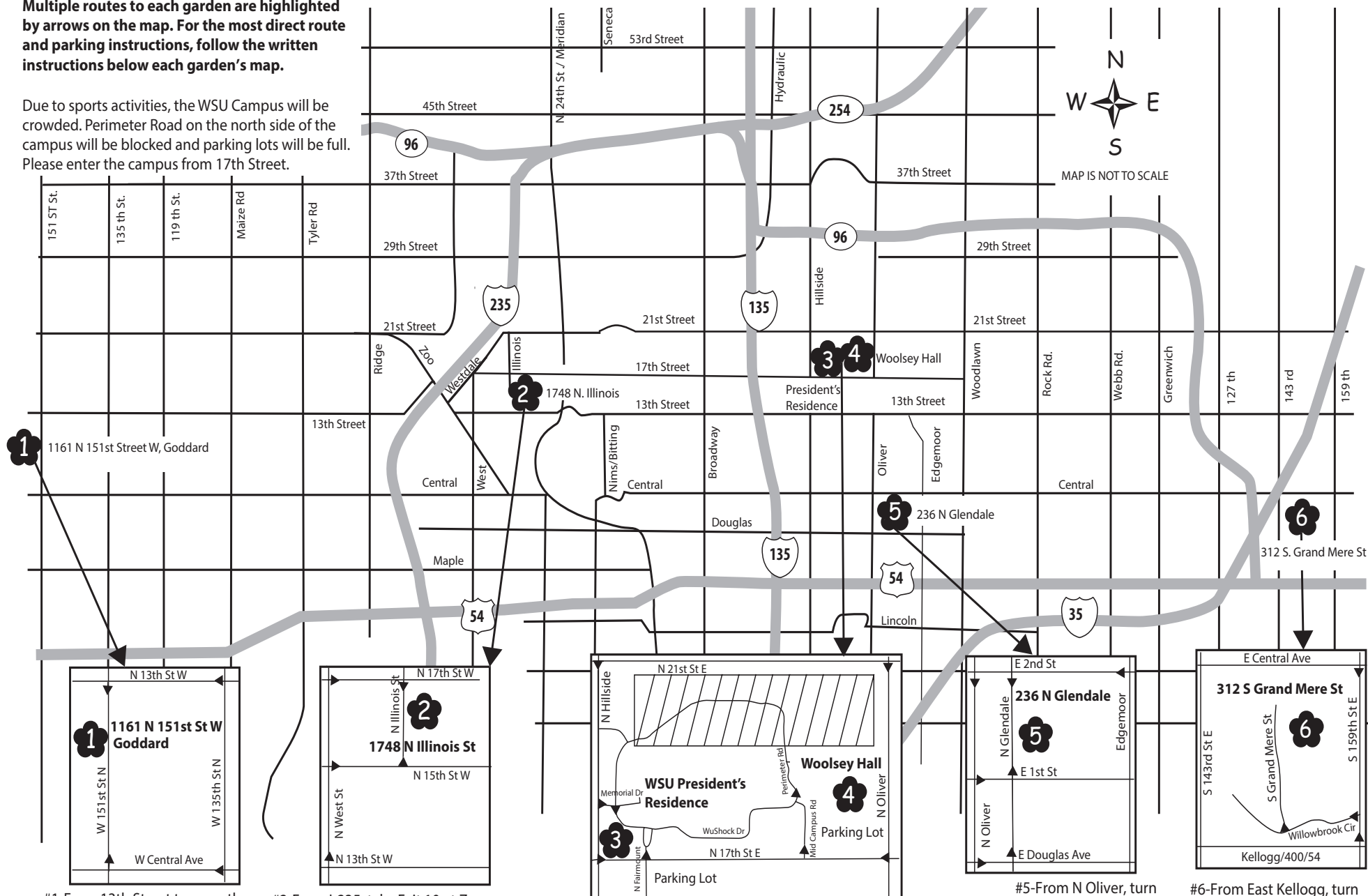

Multiple routes to each garden are highlighted by arrows on the map. For the most direct route and parking instructions, follow the written instructions below each garden's map.

Due to sports activities, the WSU Campus will be crowded. Perimeter Road on the north side of the campus will be blocked and parking lots will be full. Please enter the campus from 17th Street.



#1-From 13th Street turn south on 151st Street, destination on right. Please park only on the west side of 151st Street.

#2-From I-235, take Exit 10 at Zoo Blvd. Continue on to Westdale, turn right on 17th Street, then right (south) on Illinois. Destination is on left. From West St, turn right (east) on 15th and left (north) on Illinois.

#3-From Hillside, turn east on 17th street. Please park in the lot at 17th and Fairmount on the south side of 17th. You will need to walk across 17th and follow the directional signs along Fairmount to the driveway behind Wilner Hall to enter the garden.

#4-Going east on 17th Street, turn left on Mid Campus Road. On Friday please park in lot #39, #36 or #27. Walk north across the Promise Bridge to Woolsey Hall. Drop-offs or individuals with limited mobility may park in lot #41 east of Woolsey Hall. Saturday and Sunday, visitors may choose from any of these lots.

#5-From N Oliver, turn east on 1st Street and left on Glendale. Destination is on right. Park on Glendale or in the Hyde School parking lot across the street.

#6-From East Kellogg, turn north onto S 159th St, then left on Willowbrook Cir, then right on S Grand Mere, destination is on right. Please park on S Grand Mere.
